Applicants are required to hold an above-average Ph.D. in sociology, political science or economics and a research focus in economic sociology. Excellent English is essential.

The task is varied and carries a lot of responsibility within a renowned research institution. Pay is according to the German public sector pay agreement (TVöD). The post is for an initial three-year period in accordance with WissZeitVG (the German law on temporary employment of academic staff) with an option, following evaluation, for a further three years.
